Receive the Benefits You Deserve

Veterans who were honorably discharged or separated from active duty after completing the required period of service may be eligible for benefits. U.S. Armed Forces members who die on active duty may also be eligible, as are spouses and dependent children of eligible living and deceased veterans, and of current and deceased armed forces members. There are two local national cemeteries; Sacramento Valley National and San Joaquin Valley National Cemetery.
